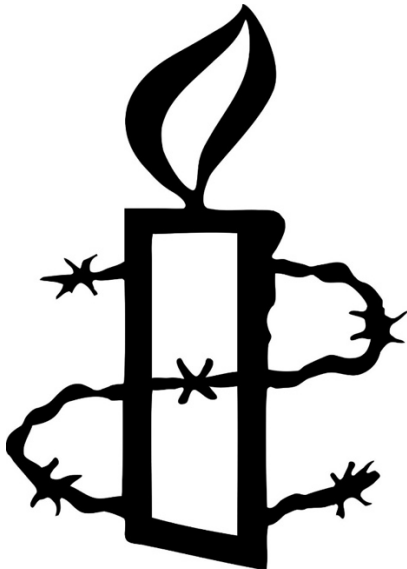

#### **PROGRAM**

Our program will feature performances by two outstanding duos – baritone/piano and violin/piano. The musicians are Mario Diaz-Moresco and Spencer Myer, and Herdís Guðmundsdóttir and Liam Kaplan. Music will include works of Beethoven, Schumann, Debussy, and Pulitzer Prize winning composers Jennifer Higdon and George Walker. Among the highlights are John Musto’s profoundly touching and timely song “Litany”, set to a poem by Langston Hughes, and Liam Kaplan’s own prize-winning “8 Preludes” for solo piano.

Ms. Guðmundsdóttir has performed as violin soloist with the Icelandic Symphony Orchestra. Liam Kaplan has recently released his recording of JS Bach’s monumental Goldberg Variations. Messrs. Diaz-Moresco and Myer have performed as duo recitalists throughout the US, most recently Beethoven’s “An die Ferne Geliebte” for On Site Opera’s production of “To My Distant Love.” They will perform this groundbreaking song cycle at our concert as well.
